**Ebooks and Audiobooks** are available for download from NIDL through Overdrive, our digital provider. Use your library card number and PIN to access the collection.



**Laptops, ereaders and desktop computers:** Access Overdrive from the library web page and follow instructions in *Help* for your device.

**hoopla** **Movies, Music Albums, TV shows, Audiobooks, eBooks & Comics** are

available through Hoopla. Follow the link on the library home page to Hoopla and make an account with your library card and PIN.

Fremont patrons are allowed to stream or download 6 items each month. Hoopla works with laptops, tablets, smart phones and television streaming devices.
